What to do in getting home from Karumba, this is important, please read and consider.

I know you are all big boys and girls now, but I thought I'd give you a hand in getting back home, I guess many of you are thinking about getting home from Karumba, it does not matter where you live it's a long way home. Rather than organising your car to be picked up and loaded in Karumba as that may be a long wait and expensive, I am suggesting that you drive to Cairns in convey, get the car on a car carrier in Cairns then fly home.

CONVEY TO CAIRNS, leaving Monday 21 August '23.

Those interested in joining that convey contact Teresa Carlson: <u>cf.cure@hotmail.com</u> She intends to make it to Cairns that night a distance of around 750 klms it is the Savannah Way a reasonably good road with plenty of towns along the way for fuel, food and rest. These towns are Croydon, Georgetown, Mount Surprize, Mount Garnet, Atherton, Cairns.

If some wish to break the journey down to 2 days, I suggest you stay overnight at Georgetown, 382 klms from Karumba and 384 klms from Cairns. Accommodation in Georgetown, a good halfway point.

If you are thinking of driving to Cairns, you need to decide early so you can book accommodation, as beds go quickly. Some may be getting a flight on Tuesday 22 August, again get in early.

GOING TO THE TIP, CAPE YORK.


